



NOTICE OF RACE

NORDIC CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR OK-DINGHY 2011

Date: June 18th–19th 2011

Organizer: Råå Jolleklubb, Sweden

1. Rules

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the constitution and the Class Rules of the International OK-Dinghy Class (OKDIA).
- 1.2. The applying prescriptions of the Scandinavian Sailing Association and the Swedish Sailing Association will be incorporated into the sailing instructions.
- 1.3. Rules for Nordic Championships will apply as follows:
 - 1.3.1. Rules 30.2 and 30.3 will be changed by a prescription of the Scandinavian Sailing Association. The base of the triangle in these rules includes the extensions of the starting line to the starting vessel and to a control vessel in the opposite end.
 - 1.3.2. Rules 35 and A4 will be changed to state, that boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat will be scored as Did Not Finish.
 - 1.3.3. Rules 61.3 and 62.2 will be changed to fix the protest time to 60 minutes for competitors, protest committee as well as race committee.
 - 1.3.4. Rule A4 will be changed by stating, that a boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored as Did Not Start.
 - 1.3.5. All changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2. Advertising

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. Eligibility requirements

- 3.1. The regatta is open to the following class: OK-Dinghy
- 3.2. The person in charge onboard the boat shall be a member of his/her National Authority or one of its affiliated organizations.
- 3.3. Each participating boat must be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.000.000 per event or the equivalent.
- 3.4. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

4. Entries

- 4.1. Entry shall be made no later than Wednesday June 8th 2011 by completing the form found at www.rjk.net and deposit the entry fee of 700 SEK through secure credit card payment. A transaction fee of 4% will be added to the amount.
- 4.2. Late entries will be accepted until registration is closed. An additional fee of 250 SEK will be added to the entry fee. The full amount must be paid in cash at the regatta office.
- 4.3. The entry fee includes breakfast and lunch both days.

5. Registration and measurement checks

- 5.1. Registration: as described in section 7.1.
- 5.2. Measurement certificate shall be presented prior to racing.

6. Sailing instructions

- 6.1. The sailing instructions will be handed out upon completion of the registration.

7. Time schedule

7.1. Saturday June 18th

- 07:45–09:30 Registration
09:30 Skippers meeting
10:55 First warning signal

A regatta dinner will be arranged on Saturday evening at the RHSS club house in the marina.

Sunday June 19th

- 09:55 First warning signal

No warning signal will be given after 14:00 on Sunday.

The prize giving ceremony will be held as soon as possible after the final race is finished.

- 7.2. A total of six races are planned.

8. Racing area

- 8.1. The racing area will be southwest of Råå marina, Sweden.

9. The course

- 9.1. The course to be sailed will be triangular including windward, reaching and leeward marks in compliance with the OKDIA Constitution. There will be separate starting and finishing lines. A course plan will be given in sailing instructions. The planned sailing time for the first boat will be 60 minutes.

10. Protests and penalty systems

- 10.1. RRS Appendix P will apply.

11. Scoring

- 11.1. The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed; a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.2. When four or more races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.3. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

12. Support boats

- 12.1. Support boats shall keep at least 50 meters from every racing boat at every time.

13. Radio communication

- 13.1. A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

14. Prizes

- 14.1. Prizes will be given as follows:
Nordic Championship Plaquettes for the top three boats.
Prizes for every five competing boats.
